





**FALCONRY** - This art can be performed with any raptor (hawk, eagle, owl, falcon, etc). It was a royal sport practiced by kings.



**JOUSTING** - Only those of noble birth were allowed to compete in the joust. Demonstrated twice a day at our joust arena.
