- one of our most entertaining demonstrations. See how sand is turned into works of art and functional tools.

FALCONRY - This art can be performed with any raptor (hawk, eagle, owl, falcon, etc). It was a royal sport practiced by kings.

JOUSTING - Only those of noble birth were allowed to compete in the joust.


Demonstrated twice a day at our joust arena.
